

WIFI

Wifi is available and included for all our guests! If you'd like to take a break from social media, work, etc, you can turn off the wifi on your mobile devices at anytime.

Our wifi comes in at the Welcome Centre and is beamed up to an access point in Harpel House. The signal is strong enough to stream Netflix, or have a video call, but it can sometimes cut out once in a while if the provider drops the connection.

Many mobile phones now support Wifi-calling, which allows you to make phone calls on your mobile device over the wifi. You can check in your settings to see if Wifi-calling can be enabled on your phone.

If you seem to be having any trouble connecting to the wifi, please let us know!





LAKESIDE EXPERIENCE

Harpel House is located on the large camp property of Frontier Lodge, a summer camp in the Eastern Townships. Enjoy camp-life by the water, with all the comforts of home. Bring your sleeping bag and family or friends for a fun camp getaway in our Harpel House.

Only 20 minutes past the town of Coaticook, it's a great place to retreat and find rest without cell reception. Harpel has 6 rooms, 4 bathrooms, a kitchen and a living room - perfect for a family gathering or weekend away, just 1 minutes from the Lake. Guests have access to our canoes, and kayaks until the lake freezes.

We know some of the best memories are made around the fire! The Point is our favourite place to enjoy the glow of the flames, while looking out over the lake, and up at the stars. Our wood shed is equipped with lots of wood and kindling within walking distance of the Point, making it simple to gather everything you need to make a fire. A fire pit is also set-up beside Harpel. To add to the fun, all our families will receive a smores kit to enjoy over the fire!

If you stay in Harpel during the summer, you will always see someone out working on the property, and there may be another family visiting for the day! Our camp season typically ends in September and starts back up in May. During the Fall and Winter months we may be in the camp office or doing jobs around camp, but you will mostly have the campground to yourselves!



LAKE WALLACE

Frontier Lodge is located on a small lake overlooking the Canada - U.S. border. We look out at the State of Vermont on the other side. When exploring the lake you will find a clear line in the trees on both the east and west side of the lake indicating the border line.

Most home owners enjoy the summer months on the lake and then return to their primary residence the rest of the year. Once summer ends, and all our campers have gone home, it's a very quiet and peaceful lake - perfect to get some rest and relaxation!

We enjoy paddling around the lake in kayaks and canoes, admiring the beautiful scenery and homes. We often see families of ducks and loons, a bald eagle flying overhead, and sometimes if we're lucky, we even get to see the beaver!

The locals know Lake Wallace as a great fishing lake. Each year, the lake holds two fishing tournaments, one in the Summer and one in the Winter. Fishermen often catch Brown Trout, Smallmouth Bass, and Yellow Perch while hugging the shores around the Lake.

Lake Wallace is becoming more and more of a Winter destination! Once the lake freezes, you can be sure to see snowmobiles and ice-fishers on the ice every weekend. It can be like a winter wonderland, but the calm, sunny, winter days make for the most beautiful walks on the lake!


- Please treat Harpel House with the same respect as you would your own home. We've put a lot of effort into making this into a lovely space to be enjoyed by our guests.

WIFI PASSWORD

The Wifi password is displayed on the side of the fridge.

SPICES

You can find spices and basic cooking/baking ingredients on top of the kitchen hood, and in the kitchen shelves.

FIRST AID SUPPLIES AND MEDICATIONS

You can find first aid supplies, Tylenol, Advil, Gravol, Tums, and cold medicine in the white basket on the top shelf in the kitchen cupboard beside the stove.

CHARGING STATION


We have supplied a charging station in the living room so you can plug in multiple devices at the same time. Enjoy using your device on the couch while it's charging!

CLEANING SUPPLIES

You can find all purpose cleaner, window cleaner, Lysol wipes, paper towel and large garbage bags under the kitchen sink.

MISC

You can find flashlights, night lights, candles, matches, and other extras in the entrance dresser and shelves.



EXTRA BATHROOM SUPPLIES

You can find toilet paper, hand soap, and small garbage bags on the bottom shelf of each upstairs bathroom and also in the utility room downstairs.

EXTRA TOILETRIES

You can find extra toothbrushes, toothpaste, combs, soap, shampoo, hygiene products, sunscreen, and bug spray in the 2nd drawer of the entrance dresser.

WOOD

There is a pile of wood for you to use for campfires outside of Harpel House. If you run out, you can find extra wood in the shed near the office. There is newspaper and a lighter in the entrance to help you start your fire.

WHAT'S IN THE KITCHEN

CUPBOARD OVER THE SINK

Plates, bowls, napkins, coffee grinder, coffee grounds, hot chocolate powder, coffee filters, disposable plates, and first-aid supplies.

CUPBOARD TO THE RIGHT OF SINK

Mugs, Glasses, plastic cups, travel mugs, milk pitcher, and water pitchers.

TOP DRAWER

Sharp knives, vegetable peeler, scissors, ice cream scoops, salad tongs, can opener, knife sharpener, measuring cups, measuring spoons, zester, egg separator, small funnel, and bag clips.

MIDDLE DRAWER

Cutlery, wooden spoons, potato masher, serving spoons, spatulas, strainer spoon, and ziploc bags.

BOTTOM DRAWER

Kettle, blender, and plastic storage containers.



DRAWER UNDER STOVE

Baking sheets, pizza pan, muffin tin, and cooling rack.

SHELVES NEAR SINK

Towels, oven mitts, plastic wrap, parchment paper, tin foil, wax paper, cooking spray, flour, brown sugar, white sugar, honey, and vanilla extract.

SHELVES BESIDE DISHWASHER

Pyrex Baking Dishes, pots, frying pans, mixing bowls, colander, salad spinner, grater, cake stand, glass measuring cups, hot plates, cutting boards, serving platters and bowls, wooden cheese boards, and crock pot.

UNDER THE SINK

Dishwasher pods, extra soap, paper towel, cleaning supplies and garbage bags.
